Judging will proceed in catalog order as determined by lot, except that bitches in season will be judged at the end of the day, after all other dogs have been judged. Exhibitors whose bitches have come in season should notify the Trial Secretary upon arriving at the site. Any exhibitor missing his/her assigned order may, upon judge's approval, be judged after all other dogs have been judged.

Exhibitor numbers will be handed out by the equipment check-in steward after equipment has been approved. You must have your equipment inspected prior to the Judge's Briefing for your class.

All exhibitors and substitute stewards are required to wear USCG approved life vests and protective closed toe footwear. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Those teams earning a title and wishing to move up should see the Trial Secretary as soon as the first title is earned.

The test areas will be clearly marked, as well as areas for spectators, and the crating of dogs. Only the dog competing will be allowed in the test area. **Dogs in the spectator area must be on a leash and controlled at all times**.

Please be respectful of all your fellow competitors!

Clean up after your dogs!

Notice to Exhibitors:

The water trials will be held in accordance with the provisions of the 2015 PWDCA Water Trial Manual and the 2016 Water Trial Manual Addendum. Copies of these documents may be downloaded free of charge from the PWDCA website (www.pwdca.org).

Eligibility: Minimum age of participants: 9 years. Participants aged 9 through 18 years must have a parent or legal guardian present at the trial site while they participate. Minimum age of dogs: 6 months.

On each day a dog may be entered and exhibited once at any test level.

A dog must have an Apprentice Water Dog (AWD) title to enter the Working Water Dog (WWD) level; a Working Water Dog title to enter the Courier Water Dog (CWD) level; a CWDX title to enter Versatility. A Junior Water Dog Certificate is NOT required to enter the AWD level.

Acceptance of entries; opening date; closing date: Entries will only be accepted if they include: the signed Wavier/Indemnification Agreement on the entry form; properly signed and initialed entry forms: and the proper fees. Entries must be received by the closing date, 6:00pm (EDT) June 15, 2016, after which they may not be accepted, canceled or substituted. Entries may not be faxed, emailed or telephoned. Entries will not be accepted before 8:00 am (EDT) May 16, 2016. (the opening date).

*Entry Limits: Saturday limited to 8 hours judging time. Sunday entries limited to 5 hours judging time. Judging time will be calculated using the PWDCA formula: 6 JWD/hr, 4 AWD/hr, 4 WWD/hr, 3 CWD/hr, and 3 V/hr. Versatility exercises A/C will be used on Saturday; exercises B/D will be used on Sunday.

Priority of Entries: Entries will be accepted on a first-received basis until the closing date.

<u>Late Entries</u>: Entries received after the Closing Date will be accepted in the trial if the judging limits have not been reached.

<u>Waiting List</u>: If entries in excess of the limits are received before the closing date, the excess entries will be assigned to a waiting list according to the order in which they are received, regardless of the test level. Entries received on the same day will be assigned waiting list positions by random drawing.

Non-regular Entries: Exhibition entries will be accepted if Saturday's trial does not fill with regular entries. Exhibition entries will **not** be allowed on Sunday, July 3, 2016.

<u>Day of Trial Entries</u>: Space permitting, day of trial entries will be accepted.

<u>Bitches in season</u>: Bitches in season will be judged after all other dogs have been judged. The owner or handler of any such bitch must notify the trial secretary of the bitch's condition before the start of the day's judging. Handlers may not bring bitches in season to the test area or the surrounding area until they are instructed to do so by the judge or the judge's designee.

<u>Move-ups</u>: A regular entry may be moved to a higher test level before either trial if the dog is eligible for the higher level. If a handler intends to move up to a higher test level, the trial secretary must be notified in writing at least one-half hour before judging commences at the trial.

Refunds: No refunds of entry fee will be made after the closing date.

Substitute Stewards: A handler may substitute an individual of his/her choice to perform any or all of the functions otherwise assigned to a steward during that handler's test, provided that the individual selected has trained with the handler and dog in question before the trial. Such an individual is referred to as a "substitute steward." A substitute steward should be named in the handler's official entry form or, at the discretion of the Judge and/or Trial Secretary, may be approved on the day of the trial no later than the end of the judge's briefing for the test level in which the handler is competing. In either case, the substitute steward must sign an official entry form acknowledging the "hold harmless" agreement before he/she will be allowed to participate in the handler's test.

Equipment: Exhibitors may use their own water trial equipment provided such equipment conforms to the PWDCA'S Water Trial Rules and Guidelines. Additional or substitute equipment will be available each day at site. Any person working a dog in or near the water and any Steward (substitute or official) must wear a USCG approved life vest and protective footwear.

<u>Dogs on leash</u>: Dogs MUST be kept on leash or confined to crates at all times, except when being judged. All dogs must be under control at all times.

Order of judging and judging program: Team judging order will be determined by random draw on or about June 18. Running order will be emailed soon thereafter.

- -The order of judging on Saturday will be Junior Water Dog through Versatility.
- The order of judging on Sunday will be reversed.

<u>What to bring</u>: USCG approved life vest and protective closed-toe footwear (both mandatory), crate, towels, foul weather gear, sun protection, trial equipment, leash, water dish, dog food, poop bags, etc. Chairs and shade devices are useful but not mandatory. The site has some picnic tables and shade.

Clean up after yourself and your dog. Pitch-in to help keep the site clean.

Trial Grounds availability: Camp Lael will be available to us from 4:00 PM Friday to 3:00 PM Sunday. Do not arrive before 4:00 PM Friday. Cabin check-in will be 6 pm Friday. Cabin check-out will be 1 pm Sunday. The beach will be available for practice on Friday and Saturday evenings, provided that you do not interfere with trial area.

Cabins at Camp Lael

14 Cabins are available if you wish to stay overnight at Camp Lael. They are rustic cabins with cement floors and bunk beds. There is a separate bathhouse for the bathroom and showers. Cabins are \$55 per night. There are 8 - 12 beds in each cabin. You should plan to bring your own towels, and bedding or sleeping bags. Cabins are assigned one per family while supplies last. Dogs are allowed in the cabins but should not be left unsupervised for long periods.

Camping at Camp Lael

Camping is available at Camp Lael. Electricity is available but no dumping or sewage hook ups are available. There are about 6 spots close to the lake ideal for tents and small campers. Larger rigs can camp near Bethel cabins. The road to the lake might be difficult for larger vehicles to get down. Think about if you want an easy site to park in or if you want to be at the lake. Camping per night is \$9 for tents, and \$16 for RVs utilizing air conditioning.


